Contingency Plan

Under current legislation (IRR 99) it is a requirement that all companies handling or using Radioactive material, have in place, a contingency plan to cover the retrieval and making safe of any source in the highly unlikely event of the source becoming detached or being displaced from its shielded container.

The most common cause of detached sources is equipment that is poorly or incorrectly maintained by untrained staff using copy / pattern or home made parts. However even if you are using brand new or correctly maintained equipment you are unlikely to have a source disconnect, nevertheless under the IRR's you still need a valid contingency plan.



If your equipment looks like this there is a good chance that one day you will need to put this plan into action.
